Nuorisopassi – Youth Pass Instructions

The Nuorisopassi (Youth Pass) is a mobile application offered by the City of Pori for local students in grades 5–9, providing free access to leisure activities and hobbies. Benefits are personal, vary by grade, and are valid from September 1, 2025, to June 1, 2026, with some benefits available during the summer. Specific benefits may have limited validity periods, as indicated in the pass. The pass is available in Finnish and English.

Eligibility and Benefits

- 5th and 6th Graders: Eligible for 43 free swimming visits at Pori Central and Meri-Pori swimming halls and the outdoor pool.
- 7th to 9th Graders: Eligible for a wider range of benefits, including swimming visits (43 times), cultural activities (e.g., theater, concerts, museums), sports (e.g., golf, boxing), and other leisure activities (e.g., skating, community events).

Using the Nuorisopassi

Mobile Application

- Download: Available for Android and iOS devices from the respective app stores under the name "Nuorisopassi."
- Login: Use your school-provided Edupori email address. On first login, enter your email in the app, and you'll receive a PIN code via email (check spam if needed). Enter the PIN to access the app.
- Email Access: School emails are managed through Google Gmail, accessible via the student's personal Chromebook or any browser at https://mail.google.com/.
- Guardian Consent: Required via Wilma (browser: forms -> Nuorisopassi).
- Alternative Devices: If the student lacks a smartphone, the app can be installed on a guardian's phone or other devices (e.g., by a guardian, assistant, or support person).
- Internet Access: If no internet is available, the app can be downloaded using the school's Wi-Fi.
- Notifications: Keep app notifications enabled to stay updated on new benefits, events, and a community event calendar.

Using Benefits at Service Points

- Open the desired benefit in the app.
- Click "Use the benefit" and confirm.
- Show the "Benefit in use" screen to staff.
- Benefits are marked as used in the presence of staff.
- Students must inform staff when using a Nuorisopassi benefit, as staff will not ask.
- Age restrictions of service points apply.

Paper Pass and Swimming Pass

For students unable to use a smartphone:

- Paper Youth Pass (for 7th–9th graders): Available upon request from the school.
 Includes benefits for 7th–9th graders (e.g., cultural and sports activities) known at the start of the season, but not later app updates.
- Swimming Pass (for 5th–9th graders): A separate pass for 43 swimming visits, valid at Pori Central and Meri-Pori swimming halls and the outdoor pool until the start of the school year in fall 2026, during their operating hours.
 - Swimming Pass Pickup: Available at Pori Central Swimming Hall (4:00–5:00 PM)
 on:
 - o September 1, 2025
 - o October 6, 2025
 - November 10, 2025
 - December 8, 2025
 - Note: Choosing the swimming pass disables access to the Nuorisopassi app. Eligibility is verified at pickup.
 - A damaged or lost pass cannot be replaced.

Additional Information

- Personal Use: Tiäksää, Ekstiä, and Kaistiät passes are personal and cannot be used for groups.
- Leisure Use: Passes are for individual leisure activities, not group visits.
- Misuse: Service points may reject passes if misuse is suspected.
- New Residents: Students moving to Pori mid-year can request a pass from the youth unit (contact Petriina Pelto-Piri or Mari Aarikka).
