

Summer Activities by the City of Pori Youth Services Unit, 1–26 June 2026

Dear Guardians,

The City of Pori Youth Services Unit organises a variety of summer activities for children and young people in June 2026. Both fee-based and free-of-charge activities are available at different schools for different age groups. At Myötätuuli School, a full-day, fee-based summer programme is organised for pupils in grades 1–2 as well as for children with an individual support decision. At Itätuuli and Kaarisilta Schools, shorter, free-of-charge summer activities are offered for primary school-aged children.

As a new activity, school coaches will organise summer activities for pupils in grades 6–9. No advance registration is required for lower secondary school students. Registration for both fee-based and free-of-charge summer **activities opens on 17 April at 8:00 and closes on 30 April at 15:00**. Places are filled in the order of registration. More detailed information about the activities, schedules and registration instructions can be found below.

Myötätuuli School Summer Activities, 1–26 June 2026

Location: Myötätuuli School (Gallen-Kallelankatu 19, Pori)

Activity hours: Activities are organised on weekdays from 7:45 to 16:15 (No activities on Midsummer Eve, 19 June)

Target group: Residents of Pori attending schools in the City of Pori

- pupils in grades 1–2, and
- pupils in grades 1–9 with an individual support decision

Activities: The summer activities include a wide range of outdoor activities, excursions, sports sessions, games and other enjoyable and safe group activities. The activities are supervised by qualified instructors from the education services and school assistants.

The summer activities are intended for children who can manage in a group setting without individual support. Participation requires that the child is able to take part independently in group activities, move independently and manage basic daily tasks such as eating and using the toilet. In addition, the child must be able to manage any personal medication independently.

Fee: The participation fee is 100 € for the entire period. The fee includes insurance, lunch, an afternoon snack, supervision and equipment. No fee exemptions are granted*.

Applications are binding, meaning that the place cannot be cancelled without a valid reason after the application period has ended. A maximum of 100 children will be accepted in order of registration. The participation fee is paid at the time of registration.
