

Nuorisopassi – Information in English 2026–2027

What is Nuorisopassi?

Nuorisopassi offers free leisure-time benefits for pupils living in Pori.

- Pupils in grades 5–6 receive a free swimming benefit (43 swimming visits).
- Pupils in grades 7–9 have access to the full range of Nuorisopassi benefits.
- Benefits are valid during the 2026–2027 school year. Some benefits may also be available during summer 2027.
- New benefits may be added during the school year.

Nuorisopassi is personal and primarily used through a mobile application.

Before you start

A guardian must give consent for the use of Nuorisopassi in Wilma before the pass can be used.

Nuorisopassi is primarily a mobile application available for Android and iOS devices.

How to activate Nuorisopassi

1. Download the **Nuorisopassi** application from your app store.
2. Log in using the pupil's Edupori account.
3. Enter the pupil's Edupori email address.
4. A PIN code will be sent to the email account.
5. Enter the PIN code in the application.
6. Start using Nuorisopassi.

Important

The PIN code is sent to the pupil's Edupori email account, which uses Google Gmail.

The easiest way to access the email is:

- on the pupil's Chromebook
- through Gmail at mail.google.com

If the pupil does not have a smartphone

If using a smartphone is not possible, the application can also be installed on:

- a guardian's phone

- an assistant's device
- a support person's device

A paper pass is intended only for situations where the mobile application cannot be used.

Swimming benefit (grades 5–6)

The swimming benefit includes:

- 43 free swimming visits
- Valid from 1 September 2026 to 6 August 2027
- Central Pori Swimming Hall
- Meri-Pori Swimming Hall
- Outdoor Swimming Pool (Maauimala)

The swimming benefit can be used either through the Nuorisopassi application or with a paper swimming pass, not both at the same time.

Paper passes

If a pupil cannot use the mobile application, a paper pass may be provided. Paper passes are intended only for situations where the mobile application cannot be used.

Paper passes contain only the benefits available at the beginning of the school year. Benefits added later to the mobile application are not available with a paper pass.

Lost or damaged paper passes cannot be replaced.

Using the pass

- The pass is personal.
- The pass must be shown when using a benefit.
- Benefits cannot be claimed afterwards.
- The young person must inform staff that they are using a Nuorisopassi benefit.
- Benefits are intended for leisure-time use.
- Service providers are not prepared to receive school classes or larger groups.
- Misuse of the pass may result in the pass being disabled.

Tips for using the application

Keep application notifications enabled. This helps you stay informed about:

- new benefits

- events
- important announcements

The application also includes an event calendar where local organisations can publish upcoming events.
